### **Notification of works Tranmere Street, Drummoyne**

Council have planned works to address the reoccurring issue of flooding in Tranmere Street immediately west of the Intersection with Polding Street. This will involve re-grading the kerb and gutter in Tranmere Street, Drummoyne, between 59 Tranmere Street and 63 Tranmere Street.

The works will include:

- Removing the stormwater pit.
- Re-grading the kerb and gutter to convey stormwater across Polding Street.
- Removing the Camphor Laurel tree on the corner of Polding Street and Tranmere Street.
- Removing the parking restriction in front of 59 Tranmere Street to enable cars to park all days of the week.

The tree removal is anticipated to occur during **February 2024**, with the kerb and gutter works likely to follow shortly after. The project is expected to be completed by June 2024, weather permitting. Access to all properties on Tranmere Street will be maintained during the works.

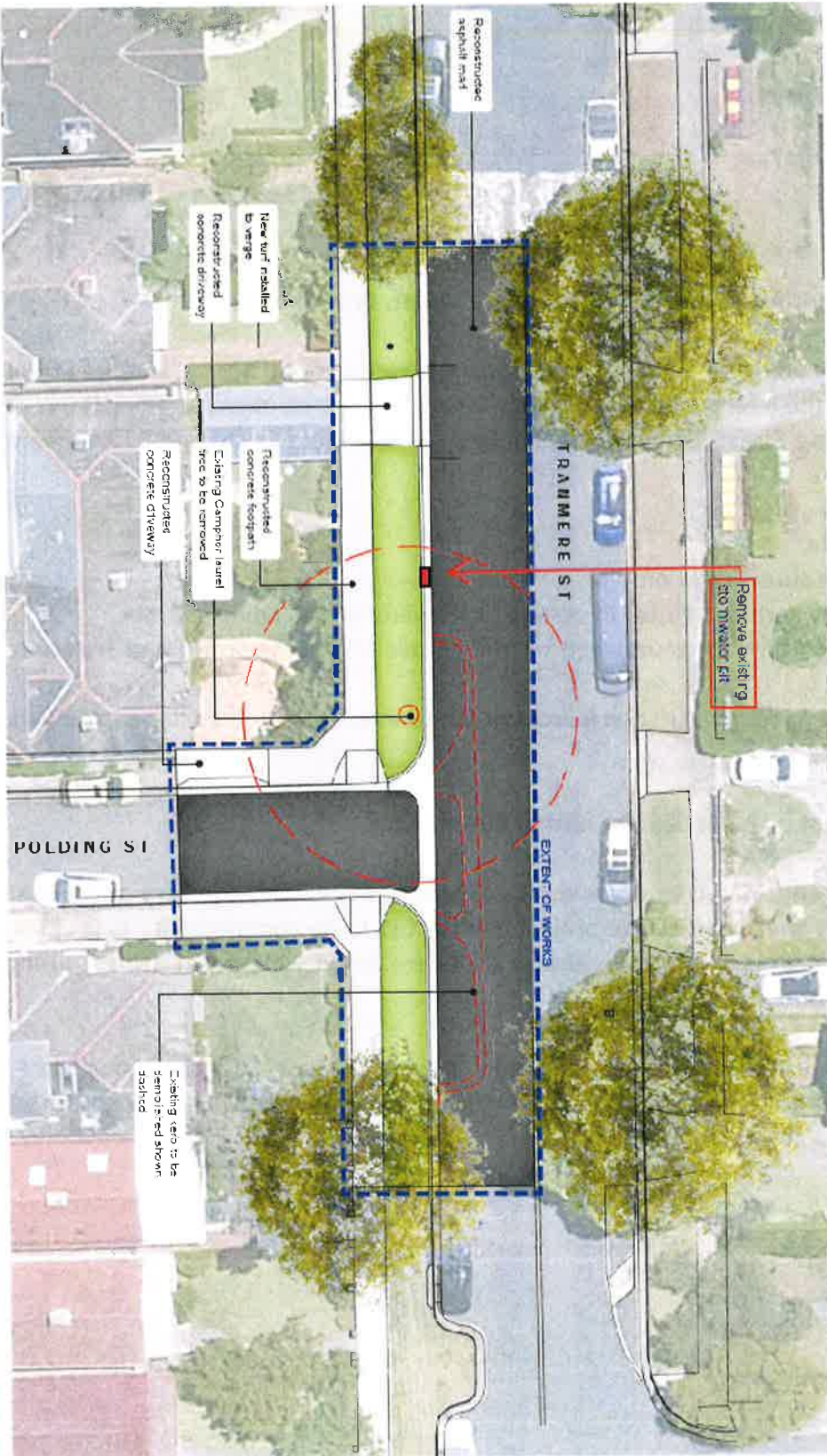
