### Majors Bay Reserve Boardwalk Proposal – Feedback now open

As part of our Open Space and Recreation Strategy, and our commitment to improving outdoor spaces, we are proposing to construct a boardwalk and viewing deck at Majors Bay Reserve, Concord. This \$700,000 project is proudly funded by the NSW Government in association with the City of Canada Bay.

In September 2022, following consultation with the community, Council adopted the Majors Bay Reserve Recreation Precinct Masterplan. A feature of the adopted Masterplan is a proposed boardwalk link from Majors Bay Reserve to Shadrack Shaw Reserve. Council now has funding available to deliver Stage One of this boardwalk link.

Located adjacent to Majors Bay Reserve, Stage One of the proposed boardwalk will function as a standalone viewing deck structure with the potential to be extended and added to in the future. The viewing deck will provide a boardwalk experience through the existing mangrove area and enhance the connections between the park and Majors Bay.

The boardwalk proposal features seating and interpretive signage and is available for your review overleaf. Further information on the project can be found online at [bit.ly/mbrboardwalk](https://bit.ly/mbrboardwalk)

As part of this project, Council will be removing the existing nearby viewing platforms at the end of Edwin Street and Northcote Street as both have reached the end of their serviceable lives. These structures will be removed to allow mangroves to revegetate the areas.
