The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of ongoing maintenance of the state road network.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out concrete pavement restorations along a southbound section of Lyons Road, between Barney Street and Gears Avenue, Drummoyne. The initial start date of October 2023 was postponed due to management of in-ground utilities.

What work are we doing?

Our maintenance work aims to provide a smoother and safer road surface with consistent driving conditions.

Work includes:

- Excavating existing concrete sections
- Replacing concrete slabs
- Installing new line marking

When and where we'll be working

- We will be onsite for up to **four night shifts** between **Sunday 18 February** and **Sunday 10 March 2024**, for up to four nights in a row.
- Our work hours will be between **8pm and 5am**.
- Work will not be scheduled on Fridays, Saturdays, or public holidays.

- Exact dates are dependent on weather and other environmental factors that can affect our maintenance schedule.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers to guide pedestrians and vehicles
- Temporary signage and footpath closures
- Partial lane closures and reduced speed limits

Managing our impacts

This work involves the removal and replacement of concrete road surface.

Equipment used will include excavators and concrete mixers.

There will be intermittent periods of high noise.

Measures to reduce noise will include:

- turning off equipment when not in use
- positioning equipment away from homes and businesses
- stopping work where possible for respite periods and
- completing noisier tasks by midnight.

Traffic Changes

- There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.
- Partial lane closures will be in place along the construction zone and may affect travel times.
- Vehicular access, including buses, will be maintained throughout the work period.
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained.
- Bus stops may be temporarily impacted. Please follow guidance from traffic controllers onsite.
- Please adhere to any speed limits and follow the direction of assigned traffic controllers and signage.
